R-16-139 SPONSORED BY: Dan Lewis 1 RESOLUTION 2 AMENDING THE ADOPTED CAPITAL IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAM OF THE 3 CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE TO PROVIDE FOR A SOCCER STADIUM FEASIBILITY STUDY AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF COUNCIL 4 SERVICES TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR COMPLETION OF THE STUDY. 5 WHEREAS, the Capital Implementation Program of the City of Albuquerque 6 is governed by the requirements established under Section 2-12-4 ROA, 1994, 7 8 which provides for amendments to the approved program; and WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Sol Football Club was established in 2013, 9 and participates in the Premiere Development League (PDL), a development 10 league sponsored by United Soccer Leagues (USL) which forms part of the 11 Bracketed/Strikethrough Material] - Deletion Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 United States soccer league system and is considered the top-level men's 13 amateur soccer competition in the United States; and WHEREAS, the Albuquerque Sol Football Club is currently seeking entry 14 into the USL, a professional men's soccer league in the United States and 15 16 Canada; and 17 WHEREAS, participation in the USL requires that the Albuquerque Sol Football Club be the primary tenant or owner of a 10,000 seat stadium; and 18 WHEREAS, the popularity of soccer has increased in the Albuquerque area 19 in recent years and construction of a professional soccer stadium would 20 provide economic development opportunities for the City; and 21 WHEREAS, the appropriation of funding for a soccer stadium feasibility 22 study is timely and necessary for the City to serve its citizens. 23 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 24 25
