1 RESOLUTION

2 MOVING THE OFFICE OF NEIGHBORHOOD COORDINATION FROM THE  
3 PLANNING DEPARTMENT TO THE COUNCIL SERVICES DEPARTMENT;  
4 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

5 WHEREAS, the Office of Neighborhood Coordination currently operates  
6 within the Planning Department, but works closely with the Council Services  
7 Department; and

8 WHEREAS, the City currently has over 230 registered neighborhood  
9 associations and homeowners associations, 160 of which are neighborhood  
10 associations in compliance with the Neighborhood Recognition Ordinance;  
11 and

12 WHEREAS, the City Council recognizes the importance of neighborhoods  
13 and desires to strengthen services provided to neighborhood associations;  
14 and

15 WHEREAS, the Office of Neighborhood Coordination is more closely  
16 aligned with the duties and functions of the Albuquerque City Council than  
17 any other department in the City; and

18 WHEREAS, prioritizing and strengthening the services provided by the  
19 Office of Neighborhood Coordination is a natural extension of the existing role  
20 of the City Council; and

21 WHEREAS, the Office of Neighborhood Coordination will continue to work  
22 closely and coordinate with the Planning Department in order to ensure that  
23 this change will not negatively affect the efficiency of the Planning  
24 Department's One-Stop Shop; and

25 WHEREAS, the Council, therefore, finds that it is in the best interest of the  
26 citizens of Albuquerque that the Office of Neighborhood Coordination be  
27 moved to the Council Services Department.

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1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF  
2 ALBUQUERQUE:

3 Section 1. Effective April 1, 2017, the Office of Neighborhood Coordination  
4 and its functions and personnel, are hereby transferred to the Council  
5 Services Department.

6 Section 2. That, in order to effectuate the transfer described in Section 1  
7 above, the following adjustments are made to General Fund appropriations  
8 during Fiscal Year 2017:

10 Council Services Department

11 Council Services 39,000

12 Planning Department

13 Strategic Support (39,000)

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
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
