	8	WHEREAS, the number of officers on the force plus cadets in the Academy
	9	is expected to reach 950 by December 2018; and
	10	WHEREAS, the interest in joining APD from other law enforcement
	11	agencies has surpassed expectations; and
	12	WHEREAS, fighting crime continues to be the overwhelming priority of the
	13	community; and
	14	WHEREAS, APD expects to have enough interest to seat a third lateral
	15	class of 40 officers in January 2019; and
	16	WHEREAS, available, uncommitted, non-recurring General Fund balance
	17	has been identified – from additional GRT revenue in FY/18; and
	18	WHEREAS, the City intentionally built the FY/19 Budget to roll-forward
	19	eight million dollars in excess recurring revenue for FY/20 that will be used to
	20	cover recurring costs of additional police officers.
