SPONSORED BY: Ken Sanchez** 1 **ORDINANCE** 2 AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4, PART 13, ROA 1994, THE FILING OF 3 PETITIONS ORDINANCE, AND AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4, ROA 1994, TO ADD THE MAINTENANCE OF CAMPAIGN IN OFF YEARS ORDINANCE. 4 5 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 6 ALBUQUERQUE: 7 SECTION 1. Chapter 2, Article 4, Part 13, subsections B and C are amended 8 as follows: 9 "§ 2-4-13 FILING OF PETITIONS. 10 (B) Persons submitting petitions in accordance with Section 4, Article II 11 of the City Charter shall collect all signatures on such petitions during the following periods in the year of the election: Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New For Mayoral candidates, [from February 16 through April 28] (1) [starting 240 days before the election, and ending 160 days before the election]; and For Council candidates, [from May 1 through June 28] [starting 160 days before the election, and ending 100 days before the election]. Petitions gathered pursuant to the provisions of Subsection (B) shall (C) be submitted to the City Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. [April 28] [160 days before the election] for Mayor candidates and 5:00 p.m. [June 28] [100 days before the election] for Council candidates." 23 SECTION 2. Chapter 2, Article 4, is amended to add Part 20 as follows: 24 "§ 2-4-20 MAINTENANCE OF CAMPAIGN IN OFF YEARS. 25 [A person may solicit and accept contributions, not to exceed \$100 per 26 Person, for the purpose of financing costs related to maintenance of a

campaign during an election cycle in which the person is not a candidate

	12	by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the
	13	validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council hereby
	14	declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section,
	15	paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any
	16	provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.
