Cover Analysis

1. What is it?

This Executive Communication is the Mayor's recommendation of T. Y. Lin International Group for professional engineering for on-street bicycle facility design on-call.

2. What will this piece of legislation do?

This piece of legislation will allow for engineering design and analysis to be performed specifically related to on-street bicycle facilities and or bicycle studies.

3. Why is this project needed?

Currently, there is available funding from the New Mexico Department of Transportation which must be spent within a specific period of time. The availability of a consultant with specific professional knowledge of on-street bicycle design is needed to assist and support engineering in planning and design efforts in order to spend available federal funding timely and in accordance with the approved scope of the funding.

4. How much will it cost and what is the funding source?

\$500,000 is currently awarded Federal funding distributed through the New Mexico Department of Transportation specifically for bicycle facilities and activities.

5. Is there a revenue source associated with this contract? If so, what level of income is projected?

No revenue source is associated with this contract.

6. What will happen if the project is not approved?

On-street bicycle related tasks, projects, and/or specific requests for information from the public/311/Greater Albuquerque Bicycle Advisory Committee members, will not be able to be processed in a timely manner and the federal funds will expire.

Five proposals were received in response to the Notice of Request for Proposals.

Project Description:

Miscellaneous engineering analyses and planning studies on a variety of on-street bicycle facility projects throughout the City. Work could include data collection, studies, reports, surveying, public meetings, preparation of conceptual plans and estimates, and other related documents.

Estimated Compensation: \$500,000.00

The Administrator called the meeting to order at 9:00a.m. to review responses to the project. She reminded the Committee members of the section of the Rules and Regulations regarding lobbying and asked if anyone would like to make a motion to discuss the issue further. No motion was forthcoming.

The Administrator asked each Committee member to comment on the proposal, but to withhold giving their scores until all discussions ended. Members thanked the respondents for their interest in the project and said all the proposals were good overall.

The Administrator asked the Committee members to report their scores and she deleted the high scores and low scores and then totaled the proposal scores. Because the two highest scores were not within 5% of each other, point deductions were not applied. The Committee was advised of the final scores according to these scores. The Administrator stated that the proposal scores would be verified prior to submitting the Committee's recommendation to the Mayor.
