

Cover Analysis

1. What is it?

Approval of the Second Supplemental Agreement to add monies for FY19 Outside Counsel Legal Services between Sanchez, Mowrer & Desiderio, PC and the City of Albuquerque.

**SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT
TO LEGAL SERVICES AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
SANCHEZ, MOWRER & DESIDERIO, P.C.
AND THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE**

THIS SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, _____, by and between the City of Albuquerque, New Mexico, a municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "City"), and Sanchez, Mowrer & Desiderio, P.C., whose address is 115 8th Street, SW, Albuquerque, NM 87102 (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City and Contractor entered into an Agreement, dated hereinafter referred to as the "Original Agreement", whereby the Contractor agreed to render certain professional services to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that continued services are required; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor is agreeable to providing continued services in accordance with the terms of the Original Agreement as amended herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual obligations herein, the parties hereto do mutually agree as follows:

1. Section 3A of the Original Agreement is hereby amended to read as follows:

A. Compensation. The City agrees to pay the Contractor up to the amount of Two Hundred Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$200,000.00), for Services performed (the "Compensation"), plus reimbursement of expenses as provided in Section 3.C. below and any applicable gross receipts taxes on such amounts. Such amounts shall constitute full and complete compensation for the Contractor's Services under this Agreement.

2. Except as herein expressly amended, the terms and conditions of the Original Agreement shall remain unchanged and shall continue in full force and effect unless there is a conflict between the terms and conditions of the Original Agreement and this Second Supplemental Agreement, in which event, the terms and conditions of this Second Supplemental Agreement shall control.

3. This Agreement shall not become effective or binding until all required signatures have been obtained.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the City and the Contractor have executed this Second Supplemental Agreement as of the date first above written.
