- 11 WHEREAS, additional funding is required for the Nuevo Atrisco project to
- 12 complete street and underground utility infrastructure related to the site, and
- 13 to fund the buildout of the Public Plaza for the development; and
- 14 WHEREAS, sufficient unencumbered balances exist for appropriation to
- 15 the Nuevo Atrisco project to complete the needed infrastructure
- 16 improvements and Public Plaza.
