25	WHEREAS, in 2007 the City of Albuquerque ("City") and the Metropolitan

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Redevelopment Agency engaged in a study of blighted areas within the City,

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1	and submitted findings and recommendations concerning the area generally
2	described as the Central Avenue corridor from Wyoming Boulevard to
3	Tramway Boulevard with Interstate 40, which comprise the present "East
4	Gateway Metropolitan Redevelopment Area" (the "East Gateway MRA"); and
5	WHEREAS, since 2007 when the original East Gateway MRA boundary was
6	established, the boundary line intersected an existing commercial property
7	generally located at the northwest corner of the intersection of Juan Tabo
8	Boulevard and Interstate-40, only partially including the property in the MR
9	Area; and
10	WHEREAS, the northern portion of the commercial property ("Subject
11	Property") that was not included in the original East Gateway MRA does meet
12	many of the criteria for blighted conditions that were identified in the East
13	Gateway MRA Designation; and
14	WHEREAS, the Subject Site suffers from having a substantial number of
15	deteriorating structures, deterioration of site or other improvements,
16	significant number of declining or closed commercial or mercantile
17	businesses, and having low levels of commercial or industrial activity or
18	redevelopment, and its underutilization impairs the growth and economic
19	vitality of the East Gateway Area and the City; and
20	WHEREAS, based on the foregoing the Subject Site suffers from and is
21	contributing to blighted conditions, and the rehabilitation, conservation,
22	redevelopment or development, or combination thereof of the Subject Site is
23	necessary in the interest of the public health, safety, morals or welfare of the
24	City and its residents.
25	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
26	ALBUQUERQUE:
27	Section 1. Because of its blighted conditions and the findings outlined in
28	the Recitals (which are incorporated by reference into the body of this
29	resolution) the Subject Site is hereby included within the East Gateway MRA,
30	and the boundary of the East Gateway MRA is hereby amended to include the
31	Subject Site with an address of 601 Juan Tabo Boulevard NE, more

specifically as depicted on the attached Exhibit 'A' and described as:

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The area bounded by Juan Tabo Boulevard to the east, Copper Avenue to the
north, and the westernmost property line of the property located at 601 Juan
Tabo to the west.
Section 2. The Metropolitan Redevelopment Agency is hereby authorized
and directed to prepare updates or amendments to the East Gateway
Metropolitan Redevelopment Plan or Plans for the East Gateway Metropolitan
Redevelopment Area which, without limitation, shall seek to eliminate the
problems created by the blighted conditions at the Subject Site, and shall
conform to any general plan for the City as a whole, and shall be sufficient to
indicate the proposed activities to be carried out or encouraged in the area
and the Plan's relationship to defined local objectives respecting land uses,
improved traffic patterns and controls, public transportation, public utilities,
recreational and community facilities, housing facilities, commercial activities
or enterprises, and other public improvements.
Section 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence,
clause, word, or phrase of this resolution is for any reason held to be invalid
or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall
not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this resolution. The
Council hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each
section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word, or phrase thereof irrespective of
any provisions being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

SUBJECT: Minor Modification to the East Gateway Metropolitan Redevelopment

Area Boundary

The City's Metropolitan Redevelopment Agency has requested a Minor Modification to the East Gateway Metropolitan Redevelopment Area Boundary to include approximately 5.1 acres.

The existing boundary of the East Gateway Metropolitan Redevelopment Area bisects an existing commercial property on the northwest corner of the intersection of Juan Tabo Boulevard and Interstate 40. The commercial property that the boundary line divides has an address of 601 Juan Tabo Boulevard. The purpose of this requested modification is to amend the East Gateway Metropolitan Redevelopment Area boundary line and move it north to the street of Copper Avenue, including the full commercial property site in the Area and aligning the boundary with the street.

On March 21, 2019 the Albuquerque Development Commission ("ADC") reviewed the request made by the Metropolitan Redevelopment Agency. The ADC recommended to the City Council APPROVAL of Minor Modification to the East Gateway Metropolitan Redevelopment Area Boundary as presented.
