1 RESOLUTION
2 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF THE ATTACHED GRANT
3 APPLICATION FOR A SOURCE REDUCTION GRANT WITH THE U.S.
4 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND PROVIDING AN
5 APPROPRIATION TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT IN
6 FISCAL YEARS 2019, 2020 and 2021.

7 WHEREAS, the Environmental Health Department has a performance
8 measure that it will protect and enhance air quality for current and future
9 generations and thereby protect public health, economic well-being and
10 aesthetic values for the community (Bernalillo County); and

11 WHEREAS, the operation of the Air Quality Programs of the Environmental
12 Health Department provides the technical means of accomplishing these
13 goals; and

14 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque wishes to apply for federal funding for
15 which City matching funds of \$6,586 are required as the City's contribution to
16 the effort of the grant and which are available in the Transfer to Operating
17 Grants Fund Program in the General Fund (110); and

18 WHEREAS, Congress has provided the U.S. Environmental Protection
19 Agency with special funding to address special projects designed to enhance
20 public health by reducing air pollution.

21 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
22 ALBUQUERQUE:

23 Section 1. That the attached application for the Source Reduction Grant in
24 the amount of \$131,726 for the period of January 1, 2019 – December 31, 2020,
25 is hereby approved and its submission and filing with the appropriate official
26 or office of the Environmental Protection Agency is in all respects approved.

1 Section 2. That in the event the grant is awarded, funds in the amount of
2 \$131,726 consisting of \$125,140 from the Environmental Protection Agency
3 and matching funds of \$6,586 from the Transfer to Operating Grants Fund
4 Program in the General Fund (110) are hereby appropriated to the
5 Environmental Health Department for the Air Pollution Control Program in the
6 Operating Grants Fund (265) beginning in Fiscal Year 2019.

7 Section 3. Of the \$125,140 from the Environmental Protection Agency,
8 \$14,075 is for indirect costs and of the \$6,586 from the Transfer to Operating
9 Grants Program in the General Fund (110), \$746.00 is for indirect costs.
