- B. The term of office for members of the Board shall be for three years unless the appointment is to fill a vacancy. Each member may serve a maximum of two terms.
- Section 4. DUTIES 14
- The duties of the Board shall be as follows: 15
- 16 A. Review the use of the Public Safety Tax revenue for the previous fiscal 17 vear.
 - B. Review the distribution of revenue among the three funded City Departments and recommend changes, if necessary, to the percentage of revenue distributed, based on community conditions.
 - C. Provide recommendations to the Mayor and City Council by January 1 for the proposed use of Public Safety Tax revenues for the upcoming fiscal year."

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, word or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

31 SECTION 3. COMPILATION. The amendments set forth in Section 1 32 above shall amend, be incorporated in and made part of the Revised 33 Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994.
