That the grant application for the Early Head Start Program from 18 the U.S. Department of HHS in the amount of \$1,920,468 is approved, and its 19 acceptance and filing with the appropriate official of the U.S. Department of 20 21 HHS is in all respects approved. 22 Section 2. That in the event this grant is awarded, federal funds in the 23 amount of \$1,920,468 is hereby appropriated to the Department of Family and Community Services in the Operating Grant Fund (265), beginning in Fiscal 24 25 Year 2020.

Section 3. That funds in the amount of \$480,117 from the transfer to Operating Grants Program of the General Fund are hereby appropriated to the Department of Family and Community Services in the Operating Grants Fund (265), beginning in Fiscal Year 2020, as a portion of the City's matching requirements.
