1 RESOLUTION

2 EXTENDING THE MORATORIUM ESTABLISHED FOR THE SECTION OF
3 IRVING BOULEVARD FROM KAYENTA PLACE TO RIO LOS PIÑOS DRIVE
4 THROUGH DECEMBER 31ST 2020.

5 WHEREAS, Resolution 17-228 established a moratorium on roadway
6 improvements for the section of Irving Boulevard from Kayenta Place to Rio
7 Los Piños Drive until January 1st 2020. Road work associated with general
8 maintenance, utility repairs and improvements or emergency safety
9 improvements were excluded from the moratorium; and

10 WHEREAS, through consultation between the City Councilor to
11 Albuquerque City Council District 5 and residents of the neighborhoods
12 adjacent to Irving, it was determined the moratorium and accompanying
13 exclusion should be extended a calendar year.

14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY
15 OF ALBUQUERQUE:

16 Section 1. The moratorium on roadway improvements for Irving
17 Boulevard from Kayenta Place to Rio Los Piños Drive is extended through
18 December 31st 2020. Road work associated with general maintenance, utility
19 repairs, emergency improvements and traffic calming are excluded from this
20 moratorium.

21 Section 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph,
22 sentence, clause, word or phrase of this resolution is for any reason held to
23 be invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such
24 decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this
25 resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this
26 resolution and each section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase

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thereof irrespective of any provisions being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.
