	9	with Albuquerque's climate and energy efficiency needs. Any proposed
	10	revisions to the 2018 IECC shall be accompanied with an explanation as to
	11	why the revision is required.
	12	Section 2. The recommendation shall be presented to the City Council no
	13	later than March 1, 2020.
