1 RESOLUTION

2 ESTABLISHING A PROCESS TO GATHER AND INCLUDE NEIGHBORHOOD
3 INPUT IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM
4 OF THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE THROUGH COMMUNITY MEETINGS.

5 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of Albuquerque that the Capital
6 Improvement Program supports the Albuquerque/Bernalillo County
7 Comprehensive Plan and adopted growth policies for urban development and
8 conservation; and

9 WHEREAS, in the past, the Capital Improvement Program (CIP) planning
10 process included the solicitation of input from the community for area specific
11 capital priorities through a series of neighborhood meetings and town halls;
12 and this input was considered during the development of the program through
13 a collaborative effort between the City Council and Mayoral Administration;
14 and

15 WHEREAS, the CIP process includes consideration and ranking of capital
16 projects by a Staff Committee comprised of staff from respective City
17 departments; and then further review by the CIP Committee, which includes
18 members of both the Administration and City Council Staff. The CIP
19 Committee then makes its final recommendations to the Mayor for the
20 proposed plan that is submitted to the City Council for final adoption.

21 WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council rely on input from their
22 constituents to assist in the prioritization of capital projects within Council
23 Districts and the City as a whole; and

24 WHEREAS, the development of the City's CIP Plan should include the
25 identification of short-term, mid-term and long-term capital needs of the City.

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1 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
2 ALBUQUERQUE:

3 SECTION 1. The preliminary planning process for the upcoming 2021
4 Capital Improvements Program shall include scheduled meetings in each
5 Council district, for the purpose of gathering information on specific
6 community capital needs and priorities from constituents. The City Council's
7 Office of Neighborhood Coordination and the Department of Municipal
8 Development CIP Division will administer the meetings through a collaborative
9 effort, and will be responsible for scheduling, development of outreach
10 materials, and collection of information.

11 SECTION 2. The information gathered at these meetings will be
12 summarized and provided to the Capital Improvements Staff Committee in to
13 inform the CIP development process. The meetings shall be held during the
14 spring of 2020, in order for timely submission to the Committee before it
15 convenes in June 2020.

16 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the City Council to include the
17 requirements of Sections 1 and 2 of this Resolution in future amendments to
18 the Capital Improvements Ordinance, to ensure that community needs are
19 considered during CIP planning and development .

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
