2 APPROVING GRANT FUNDS AWARDED FOR THE 2018 STAFFING FOR
3 ADEQUATE FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE (SAFER) GRANT IN
4 COMPLIANCE WITH THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY
5 FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY AND PROVIDING FOR AN
6 APPROPRIATION TO ALBUQUERQUE FIRE RESCUE IN FISCAL YEAR 2020
7 THROUGH FISCAL YEAR 2024.

8 WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and Emergency
9 Management Agency distributes funds to eligible entities; and

10 WHEREAS, grant funds in the amount of \$1,209,700 for this purpose are
11 available to the City of Albuquerque from U.S. Department of Homeland
12 Security for the 2018 SAFER Grant; and

13 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque desires to accept these funds, which
14 require a \$3,376,606 City cash match and \$130,060 in City indirect overhead,
15 which is available in the Transfer to Operating Grants Fund Program in the
16 General Fund for Fiscal Year 2020 through Fiscal Year 2024; and

17 WHEREAS, Albuquerque Fire Rescue will use this grant to increase the
18 number of firefighters to help communities meet minimum standards and to
19 provide adequate protection from fire related hazards.

20 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
21 ALBUQUERQUE:

22 Section 1. That the application with U.S. Department of Homeland
23 Security for the 2018 Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response
24 (SAFER) Grant is hereby approved and its acceptance and filing with the
25 appropriate official or office is and, in all respects, approved.

That upon award, funds in the amount of \$1,209,700 from the US Department of Homeland Security and City match of \$3,376,606 and indirect costs of \$130,060 from the Transfer to Operating Grants Fund (265) in the General Fund (110), are hereby appropriated to Albuquerque Fire Rescue in the Operating Grants Fund 265 for Fiscal Year 2020 through 2024.


