This Executive Communication is being forwarded to City Council for approval.





Cover Analysis

1. What is it?

The purpose of this Executive Communication is to provide a Status of FY20 Goal 3, Objective 3 – Paradise Boulevard substantially complete construction by end of 4th quarter FY20.

2. What will this piece of legislation do?

This Executive Communication documents that the requirement of having the Paradise Boulevard project substantially complete construction by the end of 4th quarter FY20 has been met.
