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RESOLUTION

APPROVING GRANT FUNDS AWARDED FOR THE FY2020 FIRE PROTECTION GRANT WITH THE NEW MEXICO STATE FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE AND PROVIDING FOR AN APPROPRIATION TO ALBUQUERQUE FIRE RESCUE IN FISCAL YEAR 2020.

WHEREAS, the New Mexico State Fire Marshal's Office distributed funds to eligible entities; and

WHEREAS, grant funds in the amount of \$86,400 for this purpose are available to the City of Albuquerque from the FY2020 Fire Protection Grant; and

WHEREAS, Albuquerque Fire Rescue will utilize this grant to purchase Fire equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque desires to accept these funds, which do not require a cash match.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE:

Section 1. That the agreement with the New Mexico State Fire Marshal's Office in the amount of \$86,400 in State Funds is hereby approved, and its acceptance and filing with the appropriate official or office is, and in all respects approved.

Section 2. That funds in the amount of \$86,400 from the New Mexico State Fire Marshal's Office are hereby appropriated to Albuquerque Fire Rescue in the Operating Grant Fund (265) for Fiscal Year 2020.

This resolution is forwarded to the Council for consideration and action.



Dear Treasurer:

Congratulations! Your grant application on behalf of the City of Albuquerque Fire Department for Thermal Imaging Cameras has been reviewed and an award has been granted.

Over **120** grant applications were submitted and over \$23 million in needs were considered, while \$10.7 million were available for distribution. The City of Albuquerque Fire Department has met the minimum requirements and is clearly addressing a critical need affecting the ISO fire protection classification. The specifications submitted for the equipment needs identified in the 2020 Grant application must be approved by this office by close of business February 1, 2020 and prior to encumbering any funds. The equipment purchased with this grant shall meet the requirements of the latest Editions of NFPA.

Upon approval of the specifications, FY 20 Grant Award funds in the amount of **\$86,400.00**, for the purchase of the approved project request; are scheduled to be distributed via ACH no later than February 28, 2020. Notification of ACH distribution will be sent via email, prior to the ACH release by the Department of Finance and Administration (DFA).

The deadline to encumber the money by contract with the vendor is **May 15, 2020**. If the bid amount exceeds the awarded amount plus the required matching amount, the additional cost shall be the responsibility of the local government. If the specified equipment may be purchased for less than the grant amount plus the matching amount, **the remaining money shall be returned to the grant fund**. All equipment purchased with grant funds must be inspected by this office upon receipt and the attached Project Close-Out Checklist completed and submitted immediately thereafter.

Failure to meet deadlines will result in the loss of funds. If you need additional time to complete your project, your request for an extension must be made in writing, explaining the need for additional time. Grant recipients also need the Council's written permission to make changes to their projects. Project modifications must be requested in writing, and the modification shall not significantly alter the original purpose of the approved application. Extension and modification requests are reviewed on a case-by-case basis and are not automatically granted.
