1 RESOLUTION

2 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS
3 FROM THE NEW MEXICO STATE HIGHWAY AND TRANSPORTATION
4 DEPARTMENT AND PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE PARKS AND
5 RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR FISCAL YEARS 2020 AND 2021.

6 WHEREAS, the City has as one of its goals to promote youth safety
7 through the AMPA-Wide Youth Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Education Program
8 through education on multi-modal transportation and proper use of
9 infrastructure; and

10 WHEREAS, the Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) is a federal-aid
11 cost reimbursement program that provides federal funding for programs and
12 projects defined as transportation alternatives; and

13 WHEREAS, the New Mexico State Department of Transportation
14 Stewardship and Oversight agreement with the Federal Highway
15 Administration, New Mexico Division, is responsible for implementing TAP in
16 New Mexico; and

17 WHEREAS, grant funds in the amount of \$220,000 are available for this
18 purpose for fiscal year 2020 and fiscal year 2021 from the New Mexico
19 Department of Transportation; and

20 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque is desirous of accepting these funds,
21 which require a total cash match of \$37,490 for fiscal year 2020 and fiscal year
22 2021 to support this project and is available in the General Fund Transfer to
23 Operating Grants Fund (265).

24 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
25 ALBUQUERQUE:

1 Section 1. That the attached agreement for the Transportation Alternative
2 Program Grant for an AMPA-Wide Youth Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Education
3 Program is hereby approved, and its acceptance and filing with the
4 appropriate official or office is in all respects approved.

5 Section 2. That upon approval, funds in the amount of \$263,280 consisting
6 of \$220,000 from the New Mexico Department of Transportation and matching
7 funds of \$37,490 for City's matching share and \$5,790 for indirect overhead
8 from the transfer to Operating Grants Program in the General Fund (110) are
9 hereby appropriated to the Parks and Recreation Department for an AMPA-
10 Wide Youth Bicycle/Pedestrian Safety Program Grant in the Operating Grants
11 Fund (265) for Fiscal Year 2020 and Fiscal Year 2021.
