COUNCIL BILL NO. _____ R-20-30 ENACTMENT NO. _____ R-2020-034 SPONSORED BY: Pat Davis and Lan Sena 1 RESOLUTION ADJUSTING FISCAL YEAR 2020 GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS TO 2 3 ESTABLISH A CORONAVIRUS COMMUNITY SUPPORT AND RECOVERY 4 FUND. 5 WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020 Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham issued 6 Executive Order 2020-004, Order Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency 7 relating to the spread of COVID-19; and 8 WHEREAS, in subsequent weeks the New Mexico Department of Health has 9 issued orders limiting public gatherings and requiring non-essential 10 businesses to close or limit business activity; and Bracketed/Strikethrough-Material] - Deletion 11 WHEREAS, the New Mexico Department of Workforce Solutions reports Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 that more than 17,000 New Mexico workers filed for unemployment benefits 13 since the crisis began, and that the secretary of the Department of Workforce 14 Solutions reports that the department is anticipating as many as 67,000 new 15 applications related to COVID-19; and 16 WHEREAS, US Census estimates that almost 1-in-5 Albuquerque residents 17 already lived below the poverty line before the COVID-19 crisis; and 18 WHEREAS, the unanticipated loss of income and job-related health care 19 amongst thousands of other residents adds many more individuals and 20 families to the list of those most at-risk due to the loss of personal income, the 21 decreasing availability of support services, continuing bills, and unanticipated 22 health costs: and 23 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque has a robust and well-integrated 24 community of non-profit, faith-based and volunteer organizations providing 25

services to those most at-risk, but that those organizations face their own

1	financial challenges to provide services to existing or expanded client needs;
2	and
3	WHEREAS, Congress recently passed, and the President enacted, the
4	CARES Act that provides for federal reimbursement of local expenditures
5	related to COVID-19 not appropriated in the most recent municipal budget; and
6	WHEREAS, the City Council desires to reallocate previously budgeted
7	funds for COVID-19 needs, including but not limited to grants to non-profits
8	providing food, shelter, and health services for low-income and at-risk
9	residents whose economic situation has been negatively impacted by the 2020
10	COVID-19 pandemic; and
11	WHEREAS, the City Council, through Resolution R-19-211, approved the
12	release of \$1.192 million of general fund reserves and appropriated the
13	amount to the Office of the City Clerk to pay for election costs related to the
14	election, and a portion of these funds have not yet been expended and are
15	available for re-appropriation.
16	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
17	ALBUQUERQUE:
18	SECTION 1. That the amount of \$500,000 is hereby unreserved from the
19	Operating Reserve Fund for the City of Albuquerque for Fiscal Year 2020.
20	SECTION 2. That the following amounts are hereby adjusted to the funds
21	and program strategies as indicated for Fiscal Year 2020:
22	GENERAL FUND – 110
23	Chief Administrative Officer Department
24	Chief Administrative Office 1,000,000
25	The full amount of this appropriation is designated for contractual services
26	agreements to non-profit and governmental organizations to provide food,
27	shelter, and health services for low-income and at-risk residents whose
28	economic situation has been negatively impacted by the 2020 COVID-19
29	pandemic, to be referred to as the Coronavirus Community Support and
30	Recovery Fund. Further, applicants shall be encouraged to spend funds locally
31	where practical. The fund is not subject to rededication of budget allocations
32	provisions of O-20-4.

	2	SECTION 3. A Coronavirus Community Support and Recovery Fund
	3	Oversight Committee is hereby created to evaluate funding requests and
	4	recommend approval of related contracts, comprised of the following three
	5	members: two City Councilors, designated by the Council President, and the
	6	Chief Financial Officer or his/her designee.
	7	The Committee will be responsible for establishing an online application
	8	process for fund requests, and special purchasing provisions to allow for
	9	expedited issuance of contracts recommended by the Oversight Committee,
	10	subject to final City Council approval.
	11	The Committee will consider recommendation of awards to achieve economic,
	12	demographic and social equity.
	13	SECTION 4. The Coronavirus Community Support and Recovery Fund
	14	Oversight Committee shall post and/or publish an online application process
	15	for fund requests within seven days of the effective date of this Resolution.
	16	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY MEASURE; EFFECTIVE DATE. This resolution
