1 RESOLUTION

2 ADOPTING THE FY 2021 URBAN ENHANCEMENT TRUST FUND PROGRAM
3 AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE URBAN ENHANCEMENT
4 PROGRAM'S PROJECTS.

5 WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020 Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham issued
6 Executive Order 2020-004, Order Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency
7 relating to the spread of COVID-19; and

8 WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Urban Enhancement Committee have
9 formulated the Urban Enhancement Art and Culture Organization Recovery
10 Fund Program for the City of Albuquerque, in conformance with Section 4-2-1
11 ROA 1994; and

12 WHEREAS, the development of the Urban Enhancement Program describes
13 the proposed uses of the Urban Enhancement Trust Fund earnings anticipated
14 during the upcoming two fiscal years; and

15 WHEREAS, the UETF Art and Culture Organization Recovery Fund projects
16 will significantly benefit the quality of life of the City of Albuquerque.

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
18 ALBUQUERQUE:

19 Section 1. That the One-Year program, FY2021, for the Urban Enhancement
20 projects is approved.

21 Section 2. That the following project funds are hereby appropriated as
22 indicated for the project scopes below and that the organization descriptions
23 as attached may only be amended as provided in Section 2-12-5 ROA Qualified
24 UETF Recovery Projects include: pay local artists, local presenters or existing
25 organizational staff as part of the project recovery scope; offer financially






