1 RESOLUTION

2 ESTABLISHING FEDERAL PROGRAMMING AND POLICY PRIORITIES FOR
3 THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2021.

4 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque and the Government of the United
5 States of America share goals, missions and responsibilities; and

6 WHEREAS, the City for generations has either partnered with and or
7 sought to work with the Federal Government on projects and programs that
8 improve the health, welfare and safety of the people of the United States; and

9 WHEREAS, it is in the interest, and the desire of, the City of Albuquerque
10 for the Federal Government to continue with and expand programs that assist
11 local governments to improve public safety, behavioral and public health,
12 housing, indigent care, services for the disabled, protecting the natural
13 environment, improving and maintaining critical infrastructure, and helping
14 foster sustainable economic development; and

15 WHEREAS, on April 20, 2020 the City Council passed Resolution R-20-36,
16 Urging The United States Congress To Amend Or Enact Provisions Of The
17 Cares Act To Allow For Reimbursement To Local Governments For The
18 Recapture Of Lost Revenues Due To The Corona Virus Pandemic.

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
20 ALBUQUERQUE:

21 SECTION 1. The City of Albuquerque urges the United States Congress to
22 amend or enact provisions of the CARES Act, or enact other legislation, that
23 will allow for reimbursement to local governments to recapture lost revenues
24 due to the Corona Virus Pandemic.

25 SECTION 2. The City of Albuquerque encourages the New Mexico
26 Congressional Delegation to advocate for increasing funding for federal
