9 Section 1. The City of Albuquerque requests that the members of the New
10 Mexico Delegation of the 116th Congress of the United States of America
11 submit amendments to the current economic stimulus bills that provide
12 financial assistance to those businesses that suffered physical plant damaged
13 due to the looting and vandalism or an extended closure period due to the
14 recent riots.
