	10	WHEREAS, actual revenues for Fiscal Year 2020 are estimated to be \$27.2
	11	million less than budgeted due to the COVID-19 public health emergency; and
	12	WHEREAS, City departments reduced operating expenses in Fiscal Year
	13	2020 by approximately \$15.5 million in anticipation of the revenue declines;

	15	WHEREAS, actual revenues for Fiscal Year 2021 are estimated to be \$55.2
	16	million to \$106.7 million less than forecasted due to the COVID-19 public

	20	WHEREAS, R-20-34 (Enactment No. R-2020-041) appropriated \$150.4
	21	million in direct funding from the CARES Act Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF)

	23	WHEREAS, CARES Act CRF funding allows for payroll and service related
	24	expenditures substantially dedicated to mitigating and responding to the
