23	appropriate official or office is in all respects approved.
24	Section 2. That upon award, funds in the amount of \$27,269,870 in federal
25	funds from the Federal Transit Administration is hereby appropriated to the
26	Transit Grant Fund 663 in Fiscal Year 2020.
