9	no City match or indirect overhead; and
10	WHEREAS, the Legal Department desires to accept these CFE Fund COVID
11	Financial Navigator grant funds; and
12	WHEREAS, the nonprofit financial navigators will connect struggling
13	individuals and families to unemployment benefits, available CARES Act
14	programs, City, State, and national support programs, and many other
15	services such as food pantries; and
16	WHEREAS, as part of the COVID Financial Navigators program, the CFE
17	Fund will provide the City with a range of technical assistance services and
18	technological support as part of an on-going learning community; and
