1 RESOLUTION

2 ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION
3 GRANT OF CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT
4 FUNDING FOR THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE AVIATION DEPARTMENT
5 OPERATIONAL EXPENSES.

6 WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security ("CARES")
7 Act provides grant funding through the Federal Aviation Administration
8 ("FAA") for eligible United States airports to prevent, prepare for, and respond
9 to coronavirus impacts, including financial support for continued airport
10 operational costs; and

11 WHEREAS, appropriations are needed for acceptance of federal CARES
12 Act grant funds designated by the FAA for the Albuquerque International
13 Sunport and Double Eagle II Airport in the amount of \$19,764,498; and

14 WHEREAS, the CARES Act requires that these funds may be made
15 available for airport use only, and the City must submit a grant application to
16 the FAA to access the funds; and

17 WHEREAS, the funds will be paid by the FAA on a reimbursable basis, and
18 expenditure of the funds must follow the FAA's Policy and Procedures
19 Concerning the Use of Airport Revenues; and

20 WHEREAS, acceptance of these funds will require the Aviation Department
21 to continue to employ, through December 31, 2020, at least 90% of the number
22 of individuals employed as of March 27, 2020; and

23 WHEREAS, the funding will be available for up to four years, and it is
24 anticipated that the Aviation Department will use the funding to cover airport
25 operations, required maintenance for Airport facilities that may have otherwise

1 been deferred, debt service, maintenance of employment levels as required by
2 the CARES Act, and any other lawful airport expenses necessary to maintain
3 airport personnel and keep airport facilities fully operational; and

4 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque desires to accept these funds, which
5 do not require the City to provide any matching funds.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
7 ALBUQUERQUE:

8 Section 1. That the City of Albuquerque Aviation Department's request to
9 apply for and accept Federal Aviation Administration CARES Act grant
10 funding is hereby approved.

11 Section 2. That upon receipt, estimated grant funds in the amount of
12 \$19,764,498 are hereby appropriated to the Aviation Department Capital Fund
13 (613) as indicated.
