1 RESOLUTION

2 APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE U.S.
3 DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT FOR A 2020
4 CONTINUUM OF CARE GRANT; AND PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION TO
5 THE DEPARTMENT OF FAMILY AND COMMUNITY SERVICES BEGINNING IN
6 FISCAL YEAR 2020.

7 WHEREAS, THE U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development
8 (HUD) has announced its Fiscal Year 2020 competition for grants as part of the
9 Continuum of Care program, HUD's comprehensive and coordinated approach
10 to addressing and resolving homelessness; and

11 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque has provided the leadership in the
12 community to carefully plan and build a systematic approach to address
13 homelessness; and has submitted an application for these grant funds for
14 which the IDOH is estimated at \$17,742 and reimbursed by the Grantor,
15 \$63,407 City in kind services, and \$716,992 matching from sub-recipient cash
16 and in kind services; and

17 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque and the New Mexico Coalition to End
18 Homelessness have identified three priorities that must be addressed in the
19 city: (1) to provide rapid re-housing for homeless families; (2) to provide
20 transitional housing for homeless individuals with disabilities; and (3) to
21 provide permanent supportive housing for homeless households with
22 disabilities; and

23 WHEREAS, the HUD Continuum of Care program provides critical
24 resources to provide: (1) rapid re-housing and supportive services for
25 homeless families through the Rapid Re-housing Program; (2) transitional
26 housing and supportive services for disabled homeless individuals through

the Transitional Housing Program; and (3) permanent housing and supportive services for disabled homeless households through the Rental Assistance Program.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE:

Section 1. That the attached six applications for a Continuum of Care program in the amount of \$3,228,540 are hereby approved, and its acceptance and filing with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development is in all respects approved.

Section 2. That, in the event these six grant applications are awarded, the following estimated federal funds and City grant match requirements are hereby appropriated to the Department of Family Community Services in the Operating Grants Fund (265), beginning in Fiscal Year 2020:
