OPERATING IMPACT ANALYSIS SPRING 2020 CIP CLEAN-UP

Cultural Services

Bio Park Tax: \$369,150 of interest, \$30,000 in contributions, and \$17,000,000 million of expected gross receipt tax revenue will be appropriated to the Bio Park Tax project for FY20. No fiscal impact is anticipated.

Library: \$20,000 of interest is being appropriate to the Library Building Renovations project to supplement existing funds. \$600,000 of contribution in aid from the ABCWA is being transferred from the International District Storm Facility project to pay for the portion of the land that was purchased for the library. No fiscal impact is anticipated.

The scope for NHCC Arts Institute Building is being expanded to plan, design, equip, renovation and construct a building for the live/work space for creative entrepreneurs in the Metropolitan Redevelopment are in Albuquerque to allow the funds to be spent.

Museum: \$40,774 of contributions will be appropriated to the NM Veteran Memorial for improvements. No fiscal impact is anticipated.

<u>DMD</u>

CIP: \$16,743 of miscellaneous revenue received from the sale of surplus will be appropriated to the MD Vehicles Replacement project. \$187,088 of fees from the Shared Active Transportation project is being appropriated to be used within the Vision Zero purpose. No fiscal impact is anticipated.

Storm: \$1,004,755 of miscellaneous revenue and contributions is being appropriated to the Broadway Pump Station project, the MS4 Storm Water Implementation project, and the Storm System Water Quality Facility project. The appropriation will supplement existing funding for each project. No fiscal impact is anticipated.

The scopes of various projects are being expanded to allow the funds to be spent. Projects include the Southern Boulevard Storm Drain and the Bear Canyon Bank Stabilization project.

Transportation: \$128,680 of contributions in aid of construction, and 'sale of real property' revenue will be appropriated to various projects including the Reconstruction Major Streets project, the Inspiration PID project, and the Advance Right of Way Acquisition project. These funds will supplement existing funds. No fiscal impact is anticipated from this appropriation.

Transportation: \$150,000 of federal grant and \$25,262, in City's Match coming the General Obligation Bonds will be appropriated to the AMPA-Wide Bike Program project. No fiscal impact is anticipated from these appropriations.

The scopes of various projects are being expanded to allow the funds to be spent. Projects include the Central Avenue Improvements and the Rainbow Boulevard Improvement project.

Transportation Infrastructure Tax: \$56,818 of contributions in aid of construction, will be appropriated to the Road Maintenance and Road Deficiencies projects. These funds will supplement existing funds. No fiscal impact is anticipated from these appropriations.

Legal

Interest in the amount of \$33,815 and franchise revenue in the amount of \$247,125 is being appropriated to the Comcast Capital project as required by F/S O-132-25-2002. These funds are to be used for capital improvements and purchases. No fiscal impact is anticipated from this appropriation.
