Peña 1 RESOLUTION 2 **ESTABLISHING A COMMUNITY BASED PROCESS TO FIND SOLUTIONS** 3 FOR THE LA JORNADA INSTALLATION. 4 WHEREAS, on June 16, 2020 part of the La Jornada installation, was temporarily removed as an emergency act of public safety with the written 5 consent of the artist Reynaldo "Sonny" Rivera; and 6 WHEREAS, La Jornada by Rivera and Betty Sabo depicts the 7 expedition of Spanish settlers and soldiers to New Mexico, and Numbe 8 Whageh by Nora Naranjo Morse of Santa Clara Pueblo is a contemplative 9 earthwork that honors a place of solace and reflection commissioned as a 10 11 response to the La Jornada in 1998 (completed in 2004); and [Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New WHEREAS, La Jornada is part of the City of Albuquerque's Public Art 12 collection and sits on the grounds of the City's Albuquerque Museum, a 13 Bracketed/Strikethrough Material] 14 public institution dedicated to sharing "the stories of our rich heritage and 15 many cultures"; and 16 WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque's Public Art collection is guided 17 by the Albuquerque Arts Board; and 18 WHEREAS, in June 2020, the Cultural Services Department 19 established the Race, History & Healing Project to initiate and support 20 community-centered dialogue in response to community concern about the La Jornada installation; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the Race, History & Healing Project begins with an open invitation to all community voices and a steadfast commitment to collective 23 solution building through facilitated meetings, public input, and discussion 24 designed to engage as many community members as possible; and 25
