Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 Equity, and Inclusion is an effective strategy for improving profitability, 13 creativity, governance, and problem-solving outcomes in the private sector; 14 and 15 WHEREAS, Albuquerque's opportunities to leverage the benefits of 16 diversity in the private sector increase as the proportion of local vendors 17 identifying as Minority Business Enterprises grows (from 9.6% in FY18 to 18 11.9% in FY20); and 19 WHEREAS, under the leadership of Mayor Keller, the Albuquerque 20 Economic Development Department has committed to a strategy that includes growth of local businesses, shifting more of the City's purchasing to Minority 21 22 **Business Enterprises; and** 23 WHEREAS, the Department of Commerce Minority Business Development 24 Agency promotes the growth of minority-owned businesses through public 25 and private sector programs, policy, and research, operating through a

national network of MBDA Business Centers; and
