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1	WHEREAS, the City concurs with Sawmill Community Land Trust and its
2	desire to acquire the foreclosed home to preserve the intent of the City's original
3	investment in the Land Trust; and
4	WHEREAS, through Resolution R-20-26, the City Council approved the City's
5	2020 Action Plan and Program Investment Summary, including its local G.O.
6	Bond for Affordable Housing known as the Workforce Housing Trust Funds,
7	which have been allocated for such purpose; and
8	WHEREAS, the City has identified that the Workforce Housing Trust Funds
9	have adequate unencumbered balances to provide the \$125,000 balance
10	including applicable closing fees, attorney fees, and accrued taxes necessary
11	to acquire 1100 18th Street NW for the purpose of preserving its affordability and
12	to have Sawmill Community Land Trust repurpose it for a future home sale to
13	an income-eligible homebuyer; and
14	WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque will utilize its Workforce Housing Trust
15	Funds for the acquisition of Real Property located at 1100 18th Street NW to
16	remain an asset of the Sawmill Community Land Trust.
17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
18	ALBUQUERQUE:
19	Section 1. That the Council hereby approves the City's purchase of the
20	single family home at 1100 18th Street NW, Albuquerque, NM 87104 using

23	Affordable Housing opportunities.
