1 RESOLUTION

2 ESTABLISHING PERMANENT FUNDING FROM THE TRANSPORTATION
3 INFRASTRUCTURE TAX FOR THE NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT
4 PROGRAM, VOIDING SECTION THREE OF RESOLUTION-20-47.

5 WHEREAS, Section Three of Resolution R-20-47 designates funding from
6 the Transportation Infrastructure Tax Road Infrastructure Improvement Fund
7 for the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) from Fiscal Years
8 2021 through 2025; and

9 WHEREAS, limiting funding to five fiscal years restricts the ability of the
10 Department of Municipal Development to create the additional full-time
11 permanent personal positions required to implement the NTMP adopted in
12 Resolution-20-104 that expands the program's public outreach and capacity to
13 implement projects; and

14 WHEREAS, removing the funding time limit established in Section Three of
15 Resolution-20-47 and designating as permanent the appropriation from the
16 Transportation Infrastructure Tax Road Infrastructure Improvement Fund to
17 the NTMP, enables the Department of Municipal Development to create the
18 additional full-time permanent positions.

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
20 ALBUQUERQUE:

21 Section 1. Section Three, in Resolution-20-47 is voided.

22 Section 2. Two Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars is designated annually
23 from the Transportation Infrastructure Tax Road Infrastructure Improvements
24 Program to the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program.




