**SUBJECT:** Funding for FY 22 and FY 23 for Legal Department Office of Equity and Inclusion through a federal grant from the Health and Human Services Department

In order to meet a tight deadline, the Office of Equity and Inclusion submitted a grant application to the federal Department of Health and Human Services that was brought to our attention by the Secretary of the New Mexico Department of Health. Passage of this resolution authorizing the grant and appropriating the funds would allow us to receive the grant in the amount of \$4,000,000, if awarded, and to use the funds as described in the grant application. There is no local match required.

The grant funds, if awarded, will be used to increase health education, health literacy and vaccination rates among the most vulnerable populations, including language minorities, in the Albuquerque metropolitan area, through a collaborative agreement with community health partners as described in the grant.

A resolution has been prepared and forwarded to City Council for approval.

# **Cover Analysis**

## 1. What is it?

A \$4,000,000 grant from the federal Health and Human Services Department.

2. What will this piece of legislation do?

Authorize the appropriation of grant funds from HHS in the amount of \$4,000,000 for the Office of Equity and Inclusion in the Legal Department.


