SUBJECT: Water Trust Board grant application

The Parks and Recreation Department (PRD) plans to apply for three grants from the Water Trust Board (a program of the New Mexico Finance Authority, or NMFA). The applications seek funds for three high priority water conservation projects at City park facilities: (1) renovation of the irrigation system at Phil Chacon Park (\$1,485,000 requested), (2) renovation of the irrigation system at Netherwood Park (\$405,000 requested), and (3) installation of a pond lining at Ladera Golf Course (\$120,000 requested). These projects will each save millions of gallons of water annually, simplify maintenance, and improve service to the public.

The NMFA requires a resolution from the "governing body" that authorizes submission of an application to the Water Trust Board. This resolution is attached.

The resolution must be approved and transmitted to the NMFA by November 5, 2021.
