

1 **SECTION 1. The City of Albuquerque encourages the New Mexico**
2 **Legislature to adopt policies, programs and funding to provide the residents**
3 **of Albuquerque, and all the people of New Mexico, safe and healthy**
4 **communities, quality infrastructure, and robust economic development. The**
5 **City especially urges the legislature, to, adopt legislation that creates and**
6 **further, public safety programs and social services that care for those in**
7 **need of assistance regarding behavioral and physical health, economic**
8 **opportunity, and shelter, and food security as identified in Attachment 1 to**
9 **this Resolution.**

10 **SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of Albuquerque, after careful**
11 **consideration of its joint responsibilities with the State of New Mexico,**
12 **respectfully desires that the New Mexico State Legislature, partner with the**
13 **City to fund Citywide projects with regional impacts and the District projects**
14 **that benefit neighborhoods, identified in Attachment 2 to this Resolution. The**
15 **Council further enjoins the legislature to adopt legislation for Programs and**
16 **Policies identified in Attachment 3 to this Resolution.**
