RESOLUTION

Establishing Federal Programming And Policy Priorities For The City Of Albuquerque For Federal Fiscal Year 2021 (Davis)

ESTABLISHING FEDERAL PROGRAMMING AND POLICY PRIORITIES FOR THE CITY OF

ALBUQUERQUE FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2021.

WHEREAS, the City of Albuquerque and the Government of the United States of America share goals, missions and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the City for generations has either partnered with and or sought to work with the Federal Government on projects and programs that improve the health, welfare and safety of the people of the United States; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest, and the desire of, the City of Albuquerque for the Federal Government to continue with and expand programs that assist local governments to improve public safety, behavioral and public health, housing, indigent care, services for the disabled, protecting the natural environment, improving and maintaining critical infrastructure, and helping foster sustainable economic development; and

WHEREAS, on April 20, 2020 the City Council passed Resolution R-20-36, Urging The United States Congress To Amend Or Enact Provisions Of The Cares Act To Allow For Reimbursement To Local Governments For The Recapture Of Lost Revenues Due To The Corona Virus Pandemic.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE:

SECTION 1. The City of Albuquerque urges the United States Congress to amend or enact provisions of the CARES Act, or enact other legislation, that will allow for reimbursement to local governments to recapture lost revenues due to the Corona Virus Pandemic.

SECTION 2. The City of Albuquerque encourages the New Mexico Congressional Delegation to advocate for increasing funding for federal programs that provide Grants to the projects listed in the attachments to this Resolution titled "Federal Fiscal Year 2021 Citywide Grant Requests for Congressional Appropriations" and "Federal Fiscal Year 2021 District Grant Requests for Congressional Appropriation".

SECTION 3. The City of Albuquerque encourages the New Mexico Congressional Delegation to advocate for policy initiatives listed in the attachments to this Resolution titled; "Federal Fiscal Year 2021 City of Albuquerque List of Federal Policy Priorities".
