ADOPTING THE FY 2020 - FY 2021 TWO-YEAR URBAN ENHANCEMENT TRUST FUND

PROGRAM AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE URBAN ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM'S PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Urban Enhancement Committee have formulated the Urban Enhancement Program for the City of Albuquerque, in conformance with Section 4-2-1 ROA 1994; and

WHEREAS, the development of the Urban Enhancement Program describes the proposed uses of the Urban Enhancement Trust Fund earnings anticipated during the upcoming two fiscal years; and
