She did extensive field work in the natural environment to create computer models for rare and endangered species. After retirement, she founded an outdoor program for preK-K that is the only licensed outdoor program under CYFD for the state. She has spent over 5 years working with children in our parks, natural areas, cultural and historic sites, and museums and feels that she has a unique perspective on safe and healthy environments for children. There is a growing body of science-based research for support of children's play that has already been implemented in progressive cities across the U.S. Mrs. Teri Neville would like to be part of a group that would move Albuquerque forward by increasing safe, accessible, natural play areas for Albuquerque's families. Mrs. Neville will represent Council District 2 on the board and his first term will expire September 30, 2022.
