to school, work, health care appointments and recreational opportunities. He has been  
organizing in Albuquerque for over 3 years. He would like to leverage his experiences  
as a Youth Consultant with Together for Brothers, Making Connections: International  
District, and The Obama Foundations: My Brother's Keeper Alliance for GBAC. His  
organizing experience began with Hiyupo Alliance at Native American Community  
Academy, a program focused on holistic wellness and creating an environment for  
youth to heal, grow, and thrive. His main focus is on increasing capacity for himself, his  
peers, and community, and to make cycling in Albuquerque safer, create opportunities  
for people to work on their own bikes, and change laws and policies which burden  
bicyclists and public transit users. A resident of Council District 9, Mr. Chavira will serve
