APPROVING THE TRANSIT DEPARTMENT'S 2020 TITLE VI PROGRAM FOR SUBMISSION TO THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 42 U.S.C. §2000d et seq ("the Act") and 49 CFR Part 21, the U.S. Department of Transportation and the Federal Transit

WHEREAS, pursuant to FTA Circular 4702.1B, the Transit Department is required to submit its Title VI program to its governing entity for approval; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Title VI program is substantially similar to the 2017 Title VI program previously approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Council has considered and determined to approve the department's 2020 Title VI program and policies as set forth in the attached Exhibit A entitled "2020 Title VI Program," including but not limited to the major service change policy, disparate impact and disproportionate burden policies, and results of the agency's system-wide service standards and policies monitoring program, all of which are set forth in the "2020 Title VI Program".

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
