She has been a Homeless Court Advocate and she has served on several task forces and committees addressing issues of homelessness. She is also a public speaker and educator who has spoken at numerous fundraisers and awareness events and is a very outspoken advocate for those who are underrepresented and experiencing systemic injustices. Holly actively promotes the inherent worth and dignity of all people and having meaningful engagement with those she serves is her passion and life's purpose. A resident of Council District 8, Ms. Herring will fill a vacancy and serve as an At Large representative on the Board; her first term will expire December 31, 2025.
