WHEREAS, in order to recognize Jennifer Riordan's belief in being kind, loving, caring and sharing, the City Council with great honor, is pleased to rename the "Albuquerque Regional Sports Complex" the "Jennifer Riordan Spark Kindness Sports Complex" in honor of the values Jennifer stood for and instilled in her children and the many other children and community members with whom she worked and assisted throughout her life.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE:

Section 1. The Albuquerque Regional Sports Complex is hereby named the "Jennifer Riordan Spark Kindness Sports Complex" in honor of the values Jennifer stood for and instilled in her children and so many community members.

Section 2. The City of Albuquerque Parks and Recreation Department is hereby directed to sign the sports complex the "Jennifer Riordan Spark Kindness Sports Complex" and to amend, as quickly as is reasonable, applicable City maps or lists to reflect the name change.

Section 3. The City of Albuquerque Parks and Recreation Department is directed to work with the Jennifer Riordan Foundation to plan a renaming ceremony that will honor the work and gifts Jennifer brought to our community.
