ORDINANCE

Amending The Traffic Code To Clarify The Placard Or License Plate Requirements For Use Of
Disabled Parking Spaces (Borrego, Gibson)

AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CODE TO CLARIFY THE PLACARD OR LICENSE PLATE
REQUIREMENTS FOR USE OF DISABLED PARKING SPACES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
ALBUQUERQUE:

SECTION 1. AMENDING SECTION 8-5-1-30, THE "DISABLED PARKING" SECTION OF THE
TRAFFIC CODE AS FOLLOWS:

"It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to park in a designated disabled parking space or any
portion thereof unless the driver or occupant has, and is displaying on the vehicle, a valid
government issued parking placard or license plate."

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or
phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court of
competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this
ordinance. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each
section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any provision being
declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

SECTION 3. COMPILATION. Section 1 of this ordinance shall amend, be incorporated in and
compiled as part of the Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after publication by title and general summary.
