BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE:

Section 1. The Albuquerque/Bernalillo County Hazard Mitigation Plan, attached hereto, is adopted.

Section 2. The City's Office of Emergency Management shall be the City's representative for mitigation planning and shall be responsible for coordinating the related actions and programs of the City of Albuquerque accordingly.

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
