He has served on numerous telecommunications committees with the University as well as outside agencies throughout the United States on issues of telecommunications infrastructure, 911 design, and smart technologies, among other things. He is a cellular subject matter expert. Mr. Reynolds is also a board member for Big Brother Big Sister and the New Mexico Department of Workforce Solutions' apprenticeship program. A resident of Council District 4, Mr. Reynolds will serve as an At Large member on the Committee, replacing Dr. Stephen Burd, whose term has expired.
