1	WHEREAS, creating a day labor program specifically tailored to the needs
2	of homeless individuals aligns with our community's commitment to
3	addressing homelessness with innovative and compassionate solutions; and
4	WHEREAS, the City's defunct "There's a Better Way" program took a
5	proactive approach to provide support to homeless individuals and provided
6	6,666 jobs between 2015 and 2018; and
7	WHEREAS, the implementation of a day labor program can contribute
8	positively to our community by fostering dignity, self-sufficiency, and hope
9	among homeless individuals striving to transition into stable housing and
10	employment.
11	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
12	ALBUQUERQUE:
13	SECTION 1. The Department of Health, Housing, and Homelessness is

directed to create a pilot program that provides day jobs to people experiencing homelessness.

SECTION 2. The Department of Health, Housing, and Homelessness shall submit a proposed pilot program plan and budget to Council for approval within 60 days of this Resolution's final approval.

SECTION 3. After Council has approved the Department's pilot program and budget and the program has begun operating, the Department shall convene a collaborative group that will meet bi-monthly to review the progress of the program. This group shall include at a minimum:

- 1) A representative from Health, Housing, and Homelessness;
- 2) A representative from each City department and any outside employers utilizing workers from the program;
- 3) A representative from Albuquerque City Council; and
- 4) A representative for any contractor(s) utilized to operate the program.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word, or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Resolution. The Council hereby declares that it would have passed this Resolution and each section,
