1 RESOLUTION

2 DEDICATING STATE CAPITAL OUTLAY FUNDS TO SPECIFIC PROJECTS AND
3 PHASES AND REQUIRING COUNCIL APPROVAL OF SCOPE CHANGES.

4 WHEREAS, each year priorities are established for State Capital Outlay
5 requests through a combination of recommendations from community
6 members, city staff, state legislators, and city councilors; and

7 WHEREAS, these priorities are vetted by professional staff for achievability
8 and funding needs; and

9 WHEREAS, city councilors present this information to state legislators with
10 an assurance that the project will be executed as discussed, with the
11 understanding that some adjustments may become necessary; and

12 WHEREAS, city councilors continually update state legislators on progress
13 on projects; and

14 WHEREAS, when departments deviate from the agreed upon plans, it
15 undermines the trust and partnerships which have been established between
16 the City and State.

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
18 ALBUQUERQUE:

19 SECTION 1. Consistent with the funding priorities developed in
20 partnership with the State, funding associated with the following sources shall
21 be spent as specified:

22 (1) Lomas Traffic Calming Project:

23 (a) Funds associated with State Grants K3180, J3249, and H3289 shall
24 be expended on the Lomas Traffic Calming Project.

25 (2) Sandia High School Area Traffic Calming:

1 (a) Funds associated with State Grant I3263 are to be spent on the
2 remaining items associated with the Sandia High School Area Traffic Calming
3 Project.

4 (b) Funds associated with State Grant K2681 shall be expended first on
5 the Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon crossing associated with the Sandia
6 High School Area Traffic Calming.

7 (3) GSI Funding:

8 (a) Funds associated with State Grant J2344 shall be used to cover
9 Green Stormwater Infrastructure elements included in the Girard Blvd Traffic
10 Calming Project, San Pedro Mainstreet & Streetscaping Project, and Workers
11 Memorial Park.

12 (4) Lomas Blvd Medians:

13 (a) Funds associated with State Grant H3289 are to be expended first on
14 the medians on Lomas Blvd from San Pedro Blvd to Louisiana Blvd.

15 (b) A work order shall be in place by September 30, 2026 for this
16 segment.

17 (5) Los Altos Park Wayfinding:

18 (a) Funds remaining in State Grant J2784 are to be expended first on
19 creating and installing wayfinding signage in Los Altos Park.

20 (6) Lead Avenue and Coal Avenue:

21 (a) Funds associated with State Grant J2839 are to be expended for
22 traffic calming in City Council District 6 with at least \$250,000 to be expended
23 on Coal and Lead Avenues within City Council District 6.

24 SECTION 2. Any proposed changes to these scopes shall be agreed
25 upon in writing with the City Councilor representing that district.

26 SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause,
27 word, or phrase of this Resolution is for any reason held to be invalid or
28 unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not
29 affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Council
30 hereby declares that it would have passed this Resolution and each section,
31 paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any
32 provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

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
