Pursuant to the provisions of § 9-4-1-5 of the Police Oversight Ordinance, City Council staff shall submit recommendations for appointments to the Civilian Police Oversight Advisory Board. City Council staff recommends the reappointment of Mr. Aaron Calderon to the Civilian Police Oversight Advisory Board. His initial three-year term is set to conclude on February 2, 2026. Following the expiration of this term, he is eligible for a second three-year appointment.
