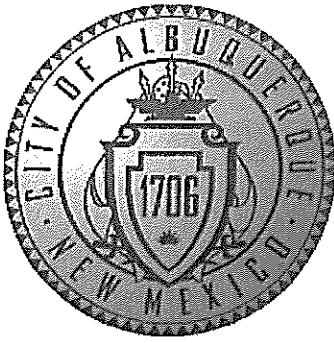

SUBJECT: Executive Communication – Report of All Grant Applications for January through June 2026

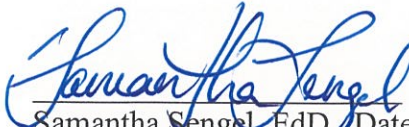
Pursuant to Section 2-11-17 (D) ROA 1994, the attached report details all grant applications and award status for the previous six months of January through June 2026. The report lists departments, related projects, grants awarded and requested for those projects, city costs, and grants that were not awarded.

The update of pending grants applications from all previous bi-annual grant reports includes 5 grants awarded, 6 still pending and 1 not awarded. January-June 2026 report includes 19 grants applied and awarded, 27 applied and pending award notifications, and 4 applied not awarded. The total number of grants on the full report is 60.
