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1 SECTION 2. The “Central Avenue Business Advisory Board”, ROA 1994 §§
2 2-6-13-1 to -7, is repealed in its entirety.

3 SECTION 3. The “Commission on Alcohol and Substance Abuse”, ROA
4 1994 §§ 9-1-1-1 to -6, is repealed in its entirety.

5 SECTION 4. The “Balloon Fiesta Park Commission”, ROA 1994 §§ 10-10-1
6 to -7, is repealed in its entirety.

7 SECTION 5. The “Technical Standards Committee” under ROA 1994 § 14-5-
8 6-10 is repealed in its entirety.

9 SECTION 6. A new Section 1, Part 22, Article 6 of Chapter 2, being Section
10 2-6-22-1, the “GAATC and GARTC Merging Task Force,” is hereby created in
11 the revised Ordinances of Albuquerque, 1994, as follows:

12 Part 21: GAATC and GARTC Merging Task Force

13 §2-6-22-1: Short Title.

14 Sections 2-6-22-1 to -5 may be cited as the “GAATC and GARTC Task Force.”

15 §2-6-22-2: Composition.

16 The Task Force shall consist of seven voting members who are representative
17 of the GAATC and the GARTC equally. Task Force membership shall be
18 decided as follows:

19 (A) Three members shall be appointed to the task force by and of the
20 membership of the GAATC.

21 (B) Three members shall be appointed to the task force by and of the
22 membership of the GARTC.

23 (C) The seventh member of the Task Force shall be appointed and
24 approved by the six members of the Task Force as appointed by the two
25 boards. The seventh member shall serve as the chairperson of the task force
26 and does not have to be a sitting member of either board.

27 §2-6-22-3: Duties and Responsibilities.

28 The Task Force shall review the governing documents of both the GAATC and
29 GARTC. This review shall consist of a thorough analysis of membership,
30 responsibilities, legal authorities, effectiveness and structure.

31 The Task Force shall prepare a report and recommendation to the
32 administration and City Council by no later than four (4) months after the Task
33 Force’s Initial meeting as required by §2-6-21-4(A) outlining a workplan to

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1 merge the GAATC and GARTC into one city board. This recommendation shall
2 include, but may not be limited to:

- 3 (A) Name of the newly merged board; and
- 4 (B) Membership requirements of the board to include how to incorporate
5 members from both boards; and
- 6 (C) Duties and responsibilities of the board; and
- 7 (D) The Task Force shall work with the Department of Municipal
8 Development and the Department of Parks and Recreation to submit proposed
9 ordinance or resolution language establishing the new recommended board
10 and identifying the Department of Municipal Development or the Department
11 of Parks and Recreation as the associated department.

12 (E) Goals and objectives of the board.

13 §2-6-22-4: Meetings and Procedures.

14 (A) The Task Force shall convene its first meeting within 45-days after
15 appointments have been made. Following its initial meeting, the Task Force
16 may set its own meeting schedule.

17 (B) The Task Force shall elect the seventh member, the chairperson, of the
18 task force, by its second meeting.

19 (C) A quorum of the Task Force shall consist of a majority of its members.

20 (D) The Department of Municipal Development shall provide necessary
21 administrative support and resources for the Task Force to fulfill its duties.
22 Both the Department of Municipal Development and the Department of Parks
23 and Recreation shall provide the GAATC and the GARTC with support with
24 appointment of membership to the Task Force.

25 (E) The Task Force shall meet as necessary in order to provide the required
26 report to the Administration and City Council by July of 2026.

27 §2-6-22-5: Sunset Provision

28 The Task Force shall be dissolved upon completion and submission of the
29 required report.]

30 SECTION 7. The “Selection Advisory Committee” § 14-7-2-3(A)(2) is
31 amended as follows:

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1 [(2) Three city employees, ~~[two]~~ [one] of whom ~~[are]~~ [is] registered in
2 the state as [an] architect. ~~[, the other two similarly qualified or having~~
3 ~~construction, engineering, or design/build experience.]~~

4 **SECTION 8. SEVERABILITY.** If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause,
5 word or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or
6 unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not
7 affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Council
8 hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section,
9 paragraph, sentence, clause, word, or phrase thereof, irrespective of any
10 provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

11 **SECTION 9. COMPILATION.** SECTIONS 1 through 5 and 7 of this
12 Ordinance amends, are incorporated in, and are to be compiled as part of, the
13 Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994.

14 **SECTION 10. COMPILATION.** SECTION 6 of this Ordinance is to be
15 compiled as a new Part 21, Article 6, Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinance of
16 Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994, titled “GAATC and GARTC Task Force.”

17 **SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Ordinance takes effect five days after
18 publication by title and general summary.

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
